Art time: dinosaur handprint

All you need is paint, you can choose your favorite color and paper.

Sensory play: dinosaur bath

- Dinosaurs

Your baby loves to hear your voice. Singing together can help strengthen the bond you share with him or her. Singing songs can also help support your baby's early brain and language development!

Here are a few tips to make the most out of singing together:

- ✓ Take time to look into your baby's eyes and sing directly with him or her.
- ✓ You can sing at bedtime, at bath time, at playtime, during family visits, or even during daily activities like riding the subway, doing laundry, or taking a walk.
- ✓ Singing the same song over and over can help calm your baby and make him or her feel safe.
- ✓ Sing a song you remember or make up new words to a song you know.

Make a mask!

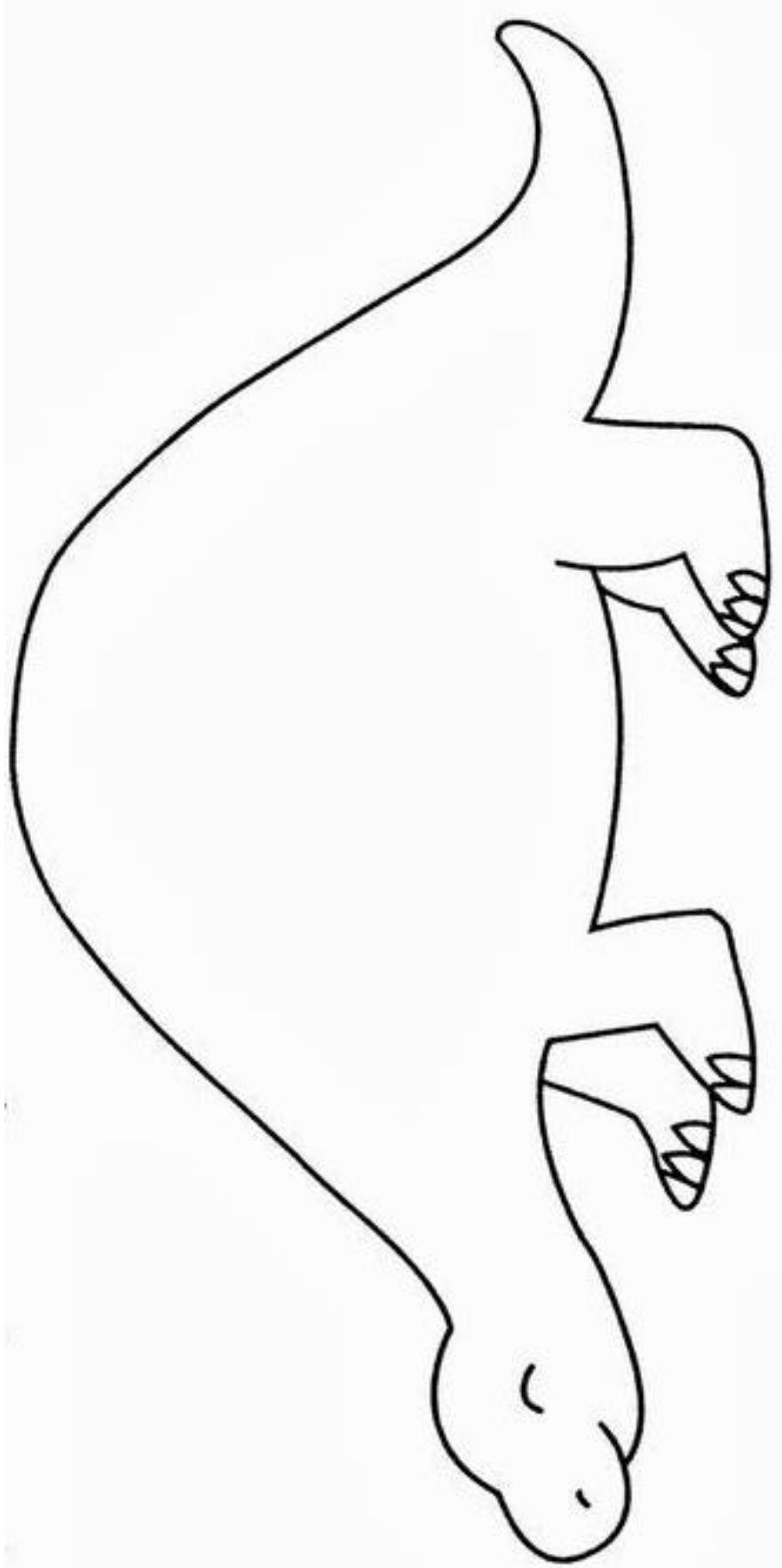
Here's what you will need:
